How Breadcrumbs Supports Site Teams



Faster Orientations

Digital orientations on worker's phones. No paper. No binders. No trailer bottleneck.



Site-Wide Communication

Easily call, text, or send a Site Alert to anyone on your jobsite.



Less Chasing Paperwork

Subs handle their own safety tasks, so you don't chase paperwork or foremen around.

Steps for a Successful Launch

1

Post QR Codes



- Post QR codes visibly at every site entrance.

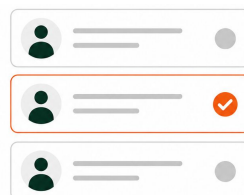
Orient Crews on Day 1 Arrival



- Whenever a new crew arrives, make sure everyone checks in using the QR code.
- Give foremen the 'Breadcrumbs for Foremen' guide, printed or digital.

3

Assign Foreman For Each Sub



- Once a foreman checks in the first time, **assign them as the foreman**. Here's how to do it in the [mobile app](#) or [web portal](#)
- Remind foremen they are responsible for daily crew check-ins & any forms or permits.

Monitor Launch



- Remind foremen to check in their crew **every day**.
- Regularly review check-in data against who's actually on site.
- Track completion of PTPs, permits, etc in Breadcrumbs portal.

Tips, Tricks and Things to Know



1 Assign Foremen Early

Assign a foreman for each subcontractor as soon as they complete their orientation.



2 Foreman Should Download the App

Foremen will be using Breadcrumb every day, recommend they install the app.



3 Drive Adoption with Foreman Meeting

Use the foreman huddle as a checkpoint to remind about crew check-in, safety forms, permits, etc.



4 Post QR Codes Everywhere

Make it very easy for anyone coming on site to check-in.



5 Streamline Daily Logs & Manpower

Push foremen to check in their crews, manpower automatically populates in Procore daily log.



6 Auto Check Out Tips

Auto Check-Out signs crews out if they forget. You can set it by time or duration.



7 Breadcrumb has an App & a Web Portal

Use the app when you're walking the site. Web portal when you're at the desk. Same data, either way.



8 If You See 'Supplier' It Means 'Company'

In Breadcrumb, "Supplier" refers to the subcontractor company name.



9 Access Web Portal via [Breadcrumb.co](https://breadcrumb.co)

Head to Breadcrumb.co and click Log In, top right. Same credentials as the app.

Common Questions

Situation	What's Wrong	How to Fix It
Foreman can't access foreman features like Crew Management or PTPs/Permits.	Foreman is likely not assigned as a foreman in Breadcrumb	Use Breadcrumb mobile app or web portal to assign this user as a foreman. Click a link for a quick how-to.
Foreman can't find crew members during check-in.	Those workers did not go through orientation.	Find any missing workers and make sure they go through orientation.
Worker is stuck or having access/login issues.	Not always clear.	Contact Breadcrumb support.
Daily log not updating in Procore.	The daily log syncs every 15-30 minutes.	Wait for next sync.
Workers having trouble checking in on the app.	They may be trying to use the Geo-fencing "Check-In" button on the app.	Have them use the "Scan QR" button or just use their phone camera to scan the QR code.
Worker doesn't have phone or phone number.	Workers without a phone need help checking in (but only on Day 1)	Use "Host Check-In" from your Breadcrumb app to get them checked in. Watch tutorial video.
